Recreation and Volunteer Attendant Fairview Harvest Lodge

Reporting to the Housing Accommodations Manager, and in consultation with the Recreation Coordinator, the Recreation and Volunteer Attendant is responsible for developing and implementing an effective, engaging activities program for the lodge residents. The successful candidate will work as a key member of the lodge to deliver high-quality recreational programming that takes into consideration residents' individual needs while also ensuring compliance with all related legislation and regulations.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate trips for residents which could include the operation of a handi-van or bus.
- Organize special functions such as dances, holiday events, etc. and help residents with personal tasks.
- Recruit, organize and supervise community volunteers.
- Attend related community events while also promoting the Foundation.
- Support resident and family council activities and help to resolve issues.
- Act as the organizational liaison with the Residents' Association.
- Coordinate and support all lodge fund-raising activities inclusive of the record-keeping and reporting such as, but not limited to, the casino fundraisers, etc.
- Responsible for the operation of the Association vehicles (safety inspections, maintenance, cleanliness, registrations, insurance, volunteer drivers, etc.)
- May include responsibility for the operation of the lodge in the Manager's absence
- Other related duties as assigned.

Candidates should have:

- Strong interpersonal and communication skills (written abilities and public speaking).
- Passion for people and recreation with an inviting, positive and engaging demeanour.
- A high degree of self-motivation with a firm sense of responsibility.
- Strong organizational and time management skills.
- Satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Record Check, Driver's Abstract, and valid Class 4 License is required.

- Certification in Recreational Programming will be considered an asset.
